He is RISEN, He has RISEN Indeed! — Various texts

CONNECT:

- How did you celebrate Resurrection Sunday this year under the cloud of COVID-19?
- Other than Jesus' resurrection, what would you describe as the "greatest comeback ever"?

GROW:

- Have you ever been accused of something you didn't do? What was that like for you? How does that help you relate to Jesus (John 18:38, 19:4, 19:6)?
- If Jesus had been guilty of sin (He wasn't!), why would He have not been able to die in our place (see 2 Corinthians 5:21)?
- Consider Jesus' prayer as the soldiers were nailing Him to the cross in Luke 23:34. Why is this stunning? In what ways was Jesus' prayer answered (see Luke 23:40–43, 47; Matthew 27:54; Acts 6:7)? Are you an answer to this prayer as well? Please explain.
- Read Matthew 27:46. This is the first time recorded in Scripture that Jesus does not address God as Father. Why is that? How does 2 Corinthians 5:21 help us understand this?
- John 19:30 tells us that Jesus cried out "It is finished!" ("tetelestai" or "paid in full"). What was "finished"? How does that impact you?
- Read Luke 24:1–6. What makes this the GREATEST COMEBACK EVER?

GO:

- Does it really make a difference to you that Jesus is alive? How would you explain the impact that Jesus' resurrection has had on you to someone who may not know Him?
