- Do you view your own life's purpose as the same as Paul's? Why or why not? Do you have any ideas about what may stand in the way?
- What trials does Paul mention in the passage? What trials do you have? What might it look like to make Godly
 use of your time in the midst of today's trials?
- How are the current trials in your life shaping you into Christ's likeness? Why is this a good thing?
- How have you been encouraged by the response of others in their trials?
- How does Paul's view in 2 Corinthians 4:16–18 help us think about the current trials?

GO:

What are five ways you have seen God at work in the midst of this COVID-19 situation?
