CONNECT:

- Share a time when you, or someone you know, took up the torch (i.e. took over for someone). What went well? What could have gone better?

GROW:

- According to this passage, the book of Acts is about what Jesus continues to do and teach after His ascension (even to today!). How does this make you feel about the Kingdom work that you do? Explain.
- If someone today told you to “wait on the Spirit,” what is different about what they are telling you to do versus what Jesus told His disciples to do in this passage?
- What are some ways you allow the Spirit to equip you for the continuing ministry of Christ?
- What do you think disciples of Christ are supposed to “witness” about to the world? What does this all entail?

GO:

- Jesus told His disciples to be His witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. What is your Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria, and the ends of the earth?
- We are supposed to move out, be on the offensive, be witnesses to people beyond our circle. Do you think you are more defensive or offensive in the ministries you are involved in? In what ways could you be more on the offense?
