Worship Comes From a Thankful Heart

*Luke 17:11–19*

### CONNECT:

- How are you planning to celebrate Thanksgiving this year?

### GROW:

- Read Luke 17:11–19. What is significant about where Jesus was traveling? Why were the 10 lepers “standing at a distance”? What do you imagine life was like for these folks — socially, emotionally, physically, spiritually?
- What is their request of Jesus, and how does Jesus respond? Why might the other 9 lepers not have turned back and thanked Jesus? Can you relate to this? What things might you take for granted? Why do you/we take these things for granted?
- Why do you think Luke highlighted that the thankful leper was a Samaritan?
- How can you map your own story onto the story of the lepers? Share with your life group what God has done for you!
- If someone were to ask you, “What is God’s will for you?”, how can you respond to them according to 1 Thessalonians 5:16–18? Do you seek God’s will wholeheartedly in this manner? What would it look like if you did? Is it an easy or difficult calling? Please explain.

### GO:

- Who is someone with whom you could share something that you thank God for? Will you do that this week?
