- What instruction is given to us in Colossians 3:23–24? What is the greater context of this passage? How difficult would it be to work heartily in that situation and why (see also 1 Peter 2:19–20)? What motivation for working hard can Christians draw from this passage?
- Why should Christians be the BEST employees wherever they work? In what ways does the
 way we work make the gospel look beautiful? What might Christians do at work that keep them
 from being the best employees?
- What does Matthew 5:11–12 teach us about immediate and delayed gratification? Is Jesus worth it to you? Please explain. What do you most look forward to in regard to the life to come?
- How does delaying gratification point others to Christ?

• What area in your life requires more self-control and discipline, and what is one step you can take toward making a change in this area?
