CONNECT:

• What's your favorite place to spend time with God?

GROW:

- Read Proverbs 6:16–19. What is God's perspective on the seven sins in our text? How does the word "abomination" enhance our perspective on these vices?
- Of the seven sins mentioned, which do you think is the most prevalent in our world? Which is the most acceptable within Christian culture? Which is the most common in our own hearts?
- How can we work together to hold one another accountable in the areas where we might struggle?
- Read Psalm 63:5–6. What do we spend down time thinking about? How can we grow this week, filling our minds with God-oriented things?
- Read Psalm 133:1. Have you ever been hurt by disunity? How can we work together to get rid of division and divisiveness that might hurt the church? How can we promote unity and peace this week?

GO:

Before discussing the questions with your small group, take some time to ask God, "Please
provide someone for me to serve — give me a chance to run after righteousness this week." In
your small group, share how the Lord has answered your prayer, or how He might answer your
prayer throughout the coming week.
