CONNECT

 Have you ever been in a situation for which you felt totally unprepared? How did you get through it?

GROW

- What does it mean to "be ready" for Christ's return?
- How would your life change if you knew Christ was returning next Wednesday? How would it change (or would it) if you knew His return was 100 years from now?
- Does the fact that Jesus is coming back fill you with joy or apprehension? Why?
- We are to be watchful and waiting for Christ's return, telling others about Him, and on fire for Him. Do you have anyone in your life who is clearly on fire for Jesus? What is their impact on you? On those around them? If the person in your life on fire for Jesus is yourself, how would you encourage others to live with the same fire for Jesus?
- One of the aspects of "being ready" is to confess our sins promptly and keep short accounts with the Lord. What prayer practices do you use in your life to be consistent in prayer? How has this impacted your faith? Is this something that needs improvement in your life?
