4.	Prayer that is effective comes from lips of confessed-up, and repented-up, sinners (<u>Psalm 66:18</u> ; <u>Proverbs 28:9</u> ; <u>1 Peter 3:7</u>)
5.	Prayer should be accompanied by faith in the God who can do all things (James 1:6-8).
