- Read Habakkuk 3. Compare / contrast Habakkuk's attitude here with his attitude in Habakkuk 1:12-2:1.
- How does Habakkuk 2:4 help us understand the shift in the prophet's attitude?
- Read Habakkuk 3:17-19 and Romans 8:28 and answer the following questions in light of these two passages:
 - What do these passages hold in common?
 - How do these passages help us when we are tempted to complain?
 - How do these passages help us when we believe we are being treated unfairly and may be tempted to bitterness?
 - The greatest evil ever was the Son of God being crucified on a cross by people He had lovingly fashioned. How was God's plan accomplished even in this horrific evil?

What is your biggest personal take away from the four sermons from Habakkuk?

GO:

- As you hang onto these truths, in what ways will you make Jesus look very attractive to those who may be far from faith (and those who are near, too!)?
