Pairs and <u>Spares</u>? NO WAY! Marriage AND Singleness Are Commended by God! 1 Corinthians 7:25–40 Pastor Jeff Hinds

## Our Mission:

- 1. God values marriage (Genesis 2; Song of Songs; Ephesians 5).
- 2. God values singleness (1 Corinthians 7; life of Jesus and Paul; life of Anna; etc.).
- God's Word teaches that while both marriage and singleness are gifts (<u>charisma</u> –

   Corinthians 7:7–8), and while both are God-ordained and pleasing to the Lord, a single person has a spiritual advantage over a married person. A single can be "even more focused" on growing in Christ and serving Him (1 Corinthians 7:32–34).
- 4. God's Word teaches that it is normal and right for some singles to desire marriages (1 Corinthians 7:28, 36–38).
- 5. God's Word teaches that it is normal and right for some singles to desire singleness as an avenue towards greater intimacy with Jesus (1 Corinthians 7:25–29, 34).
