### CONNECT

- Got an interesting graduation story? Share it with your life group.

### GROW

- Read Exodus 20:1–17. First of all, note in verse 2 that God has rescued His people from slavery in Egypt—He went after them before they began keeping His commands. What does this teach us about the gospel (see also Romans 5:6–8)? How does this motivate you to keep God's commands?
- What is the 1<sup>st</sup> commandment? What are significant idols (gods) in our culture? Which of these might be a temptation to you?
- What is the 9<sup>th</sup> commandment, and what does this have to do with living a life of integrity? Where do we see this violated in our culture? Where in our day-to-day lives are we most tempted to violate this command?
- What is the 10<sup>th</sup> commandment? In what way is the 10<sup>th</sup> commandment different from the previous 9? What does this teach us about the origin of sin (see also Mark 7:20–23)? How is covetousness the opposite of thankfulness? In which areas of life are you prone to be most envious?
- Where have you seen God transforming you when it comes to Commands 1, 9, and 10?

### GO

- As you consider God's faithfulness in rescuing you, where is He calling you to repentance and trusting in Him? What will you do about this?
