Glow for Jesus Romans 1:17, 12:1–2 Pastors Jeff Hinds

CONNECT:

 When you were a child, what/who did you want to be when you grew up? Did it come true?

GROW:

- Read Romans 1:17. The word "righteousness" is translated
 "justification." It means God declares us righteous as a
 gift. Sometimes (depending on our personality or faith
 background) it is difficult not to add our own performance to this
 gift. Is this a struggle for you (now or in the past)? What types of
 things do you tend to add?
- Read Romans 12:1-2. We are called to present our bodies as a living sacrifice to the Lord - our complete person is to honor God. What does it mean to honor God with our mind? Finances? Time? What we see? What we say? (Give examples). What has been the most difficult area in your life to surrender? What are you still working on?
- We are not to be confirmed to this world...and we have the help of the Holy Spirit to accomplish this. Does this change the way you approach this command? In what way?

<u>GO:</u>

 How does knowing that as a believer you are a child of the King impact your daily decisions? What can you do this week to remind yourself of who you are?
